Board of Directors

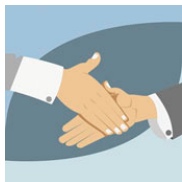
Members of the MAPCS Board of Directors are responsible for ensuring that the association stays on track in meeting the organization's mission, services, policies and programs. Board members have a fiduciary responsibility to review and approve the association's budget and financial strategy. They approve major policies, serve on committees or task forces, take on special assignments and promote the association to others in the private career school industry.

Education Committee



The MAPCS Education Committee is responsible for determining the membership's educational needs and implementing programs to meet those specific needs.

The Education Committee also plans the MAPCS Annual Conference, which features numerous educational workshops and exhibits, as well as networking and constructive interaction with public officials, vendors, faculty, school owners and administrators.



Membership Committee

MAPCS recognizes that the most effective marketing tool for membership growth is a peer to peer recruitment and retention program led by volunteer members.

The MAPCS Membership Committee develops strategic plans and sets recruitment and retention goals each year.

Government Affairs Committee



The MAPCS Government Affairs Committee is responsible for representing and protecting the private career industry's legislative interests.

The MAPCS Government Affairs Committee's most recent project is the development of the association's Economic Impact Report. The report will expand the private career school profile and provide strategic partners including guidance counselors, workforce development agencies, students, parents, legislators and government officials with a comprehensive directory of the industry.

The Economic Impact Report will provide a profile of the Massachusetts private career industry and the number of students that graduate each year who enter the workforce ready and trained to make a positive contribution to the Massachusetts economy.



Regulatory Committee

The MAPCS Regulatory Committee is responsible for representing and protecting the private career industry's regulatory interests.

The MAPCS Regulatory Committee is currently working to modify the problematic requirements that have impeded our member's ability to recruit and retain qualified teachers.
